Tuition

General Information

The camp is planned to provide comprehensive skill instruction for intermediate and beginning players. Emphasis will be placed on fundamentals, individual skill development, and team strategy. Our staff excels in all three lacrosse positions: attack, midfield, and defense including goalie. The camp will also include guest lectures, demonstrations, daily competitions, and awards to contest winners and team champions.

2. Player - Coach ratio at least 7:1, maintained
3. Player should come properly dressed; locker facilities are not available
4. Parents should arrange adequate accident insurance coverage.

6. Awards will be given to contest winners for shooting, groundballs, face-offs, and most improved campers.
